Please remember to buy tickets for the KS1/KS2 disco via Arbour at a cost of £2 per ticket. Thursday 26th March

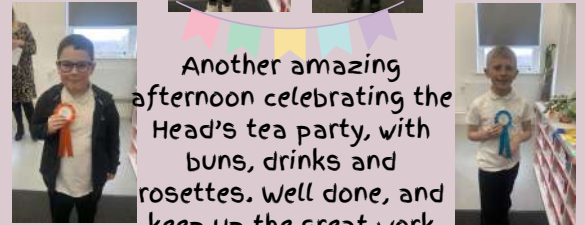
Red Nose Day
